- Cover Crops
- Mulch
- Reduced- or No-Till
- Hedgerow Plantings
- Riparian Plantings
- Windbreak Plantings
- Field Borders, Filter Strips, etc.
- Silvopasture

## **Incentive Payments** Payment rates per acre, feet, or ton Examples • Reduced-Till: \$31.24/acre Compost: \$35/dry ton • Cover Crop: \$123.82/acre • Mulch: \$376.56/acre Hedgerow Planting: \$5.94/foot • Silvopasture: \$193.90/acre (20) plantings/acre) Grants up to \$50,000 for 3-year project






#### **Incentives Projects by Land Use Type**

#### **Next Round**

- When?
  - Fall 2018 (best guess based on funding prospects and comments from CDFA)
- How much funding?
  - \$9 million if voters approve the Proposition 68 "Parks & Water" bond measure on the June 5<sup>th</sup> ballot
  - \$5 million if the legislature passes the Governor's proposed budget
- What will be different?
  - Some new practices likely (30+ proposed and under review)
  - Improved program guidelines and application (we hope!)


#### How to Prepare to Apply
